

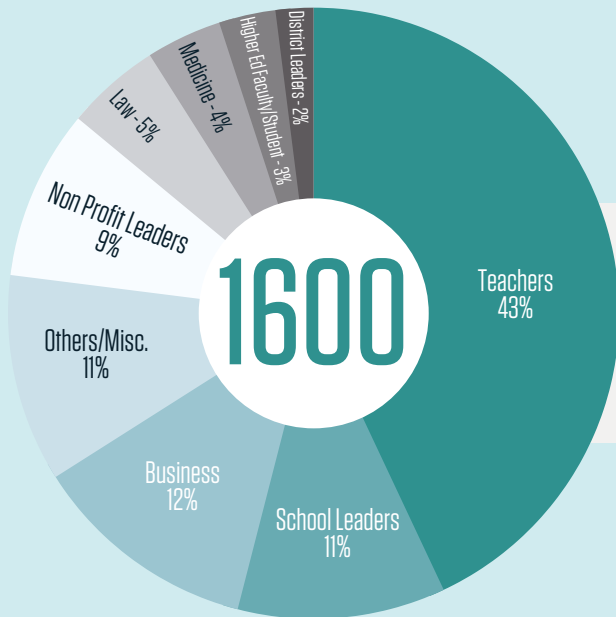

## MAKING AN IMPACT IN CLASSROOMS ACROSS DALLAS-FORT WORTH

On average, TFA-led classrooms had stronger results on the STAAR exam, and TFA-led schools had better overall accountability ratings while serving higher proportions of economically disadvantaged students.

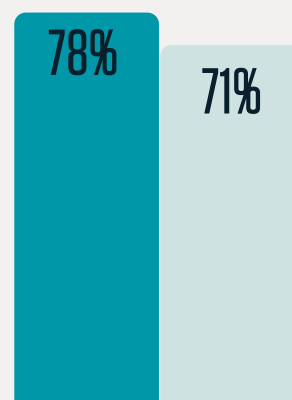

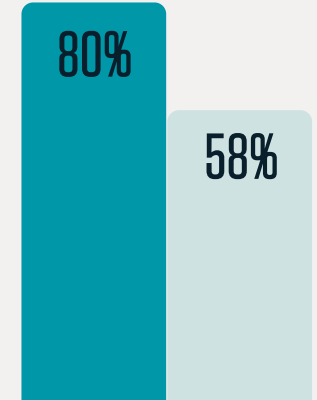
CORPS MEMBER CLASSROOMS NON-CORPS MEMBER CLASSROOMS
